Beckhead Park, Haze Lane - Proposal: T1 Oak – Lateral reduction of the crown in the direction of the lean by approx. 2 meters to a suitable growth point.

T2 Oak – Selective pruning of the overhanging scaffold limb by approx. 3 meters to a suitable growth point

T3 Oak – Selective pruning of the limbs over the site building to approximately the apex of the buildings roof and the selective pruning of lateral branches overhanging the dwelling by approximately 1.5meters to a suitable growth point.

T4 Oak – Radial reduction of a large bough limb on the southern aspect by approximately 2-3 meters to reduce end weight and remove deadwood.
